On-Campus Resident

All full-time undergraduate students are guaranteed on-campus housing. Students whose permanent address is more than 50 miles from the College are required to live on campus.

Commuter

Students living with a parent or legal guardian within a 50-mile radius of the College.

Off-Campus Resident

Eligible students who apply for and are approved (by the College) to rent from a private landlord, in non-College provided housing.

Understanding the Residence Hall Room Contract

A student and/or guardian who acknowledges the Residence Hall Room Contract, is obligated to be a resident and is expected to participate in a college meal plan for the full academic year.

Off-Campus Application Eligibility Criteria

Junior or senior, or 20 years of age by the first day of the fall semester
 Minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA
 Good financial and conduct standing

WHEN TO REQUEST A CHANGE OF HOUSING STATUS

New Students

Students interested in changing housing status, from what was indicated on the FAFSA and application, must contact the Office of Admissions prior to June.

Returning Students

Students interested in changing status for the upcoming year are expected to complete the Housing Status Application during the spring semester. Students who do not complete the Housing Status Application will continue as an on-campus resident or commuter, based on their permanent address.
