

Project Management

As usual, Facilities is very busy with summer projects. Here are a few highlights:

- Rau Hassler is getting new boilers. The boilers are original to the building, so well overdue for replacement.
- Beck & DeSchweinitz are scheduled to have their windows replaced. We can no longer get replacement parts for these units, so this is a welcome project to our carpenters!
- Bernhardt Wilhelm has already received new vinyl flooring, and new furniture is arriving in late July.
- Small but welcome improvements are coming with the addition of water bottle fillers to Main Hall and the lower level of Reeves Library
- The running surface at the Timothy Breidegam Track is being replaced this summer. The old surface has already been removed, and a new asphalt base has been poured. Once the asphalt has cured, we will install the new surface with the goal of having everything completed before football returns in the fall for practice.
- The HUB renovation and expansion is moving along! Everyone was successfully relocated from the building over Winter Break, and PPHAC has been serving as the new "Hub" for campus meetings, activities, etc. The majority of the HUB was demolished in early March which the students and staff enjoyed watching. The old Student Life Suite on the lower level has also been fully demolished. There is lots of structural steel work to do in the B&G and the Star to connect the old building to the new structure. Concrete footings and foundations are being poured for the new addition in the hopes that we'll see the new steel structure going up mid-summer. -Amber
