

This AGREEMENT made DATE by and between MORAVIAN UNIVERSITY (hereinafter referred to as 'the University'), party of the first part; and CONTRACTOR/ARTIST NAME (hereinafter referred to as 'CONTRACTOR/ARTIST'), party of the second part.

WITNESSETH:

In consideration of the mutual promises and covenants contained herein, the parties hereto do agree as follows:

- 1. Contractor/Artist agrees to provide EXPLANATION OF SERVICES. Said services are to be executed in the following location on DATE at LOCATION, Moravian University, 1200 Main Street, Bethlehem, PA 18018.
- 2. Contractor/Artist agrees to be prepared to begin said services promptly at TIME meaning that Contractor should arrive no later than TIME. Event is set to conclude at TIME.
- 3. The University agrees to pay Contractor/Artist, in consideration for said services, a sum of TYPE OUT DOLLAR AMOUNT IN WORDS \$X.XX payable by check following the performance upon the receipt of the executed contract and W-9.
- 4. Contractor/Artist agrees to indemnify the University and will submit insurance certificate naming the University as Additional Insured. It is agreed and understood by the University and the Contractor/Artist that the Contractor/Artist shall carry sufficient insurance coverage to cover any and all liabilities which may occur as a result of the Contractor's/Artist's actions during their stay or performance, and the Contractor/Artist further agrees to hold the University harmless from these damages.
- 5. Contractor/Artist will set up their own equipment prior to the required start time without the University's event management assistance. The University will supply Contractor/Artist with access to electrical & data outlets, and other items as specified.
- 6. It is specifically understood and agreed that the Contractor/Artist herein is acting solely as an independent contractor, and not in any way as an agent, servant or employee of the University.
- 7. The agreement of the Contractor/Artist to perform is subject to proven detention by sickness, accidents, riots, strikers, epidemics, acts of God, or any other legitimate condition beyond the Contractor's/Artist's control. It is further agreed that the University shall not be liable for payment in the event that the Contractor/Artist fails to perform for whatever the reason. The Contractor/Artist is liable for all cost incurred by the University in the event the Contractor/Artist fails to perform (subject to proven detention).
- 8. The University shall retain the right to photograph the performance for publication in and for its student publications, including but not limited to the University's yearbook, Student Newspaper and any other University publication.
- 9. If this contract is cancelled by the Contractor/Artist within the terms of the cancellation clause contained herein, the Contractor/Artist agrees, at the University's option, to reschedule performance at the earliest possible date convenient to both parties under the terms of this contract. The decision whether or not to reschedule is at the sole discretion of the University.
- 10. This contract shall be construed and governed in all respects according to the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

- 11. No oral representative, warranty, condition or agreement of any nature whatsoever shall be binding upon the parties hereto unless incorporated into this agreement. This contract, along with any addendum, contains all the terms and conditions agreed to by the parties hereto, and may not be amended other than in writing.
- 12. Moravian University does not discriminate in admission, employment, access, or contracting by race, color, religion, age, gender, gender identity, national origin, ancestry, handicap, sexual orientation, political affiliation, status as a protected veteran, or any characteristic against which discrimination is prohibited by applicable law, and operates on a nondiscriminatory basis throughout the institution. This policy is in accordance with the State law including the Pennsylvania Human Relations Act and with Federal law, including Titles VI and VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, Title IX of the Education Amendments of 1972, Sections 503 and 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, the Age Discrimination Act of 1975, and the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990.
