

MORAVIAN UNIVERSITY BULLYING POLICY

Moravian University strives to be a campus community free from bullying, where each member of our community is treated with dignity and respect. As such, the institution reserves the right to address bullying behaviors that seemingly undermine these values. This policy specifically applies when behavior is not based on membership in a protected class, but may negatively impact on the living, learning, or working environment.

For purposes of this policy, bullying is defined as

Repeated and/or severe behavior that is likely to intimidate or intentionally harm or control another person physically or emotionally, and which is not protected by freedom of expression. This includes behavior that may occur online (also known as cyberbullying), in person, by telephone, mail, or any other action, device, or method.
