

School of Nursing and Public Health Code of Conduct

The Helen S. Breidegam School of Nursing and Public Health follows the same community and safety standards/standards of conduct as those that are outlined by Moravian University. Any student found possessing, using or distributing explosives (including fireworks and ammunition), guns (including air, BB, paintball, facsimile weapons and pellet guns), or other weapons or dangerous objects such as arrows, axes, machetes, nunchucks, throwing stars, or knives (other than ordinary pocket knives carried in a closed position with a blade less than three inches in length or cutlery of reasonable size when used or stored in a kitchen or other food preparation area), including the storage of any item covered under this section in a vehicle parked on University property or clinical agency property will be subject to dismissal from the program.
